OPEN HORTICULTURAL SECTION

The Society has pleasure in inviting applications for Trade Displays at the forthcoming Derbyshire County Show. The following awards are offered for the best exhibits in this section with a frontage of not less than 12ft (which may be increased by multiples of 6ft) and the stand depth to be 4ft or 6ft

Large Gold Medal Card(s) with cash award of £170

Gold Medal Card(s) with a cash award of £130 each

Silver Gilt Medal Card(s) with a cash award of £100 each

Silver Medal Card(s) with a cash award of £80 each

Bronze Medal Card(s) with a cash award of £60 each

Highly Commended Card(s) with a Cash award of £45 each

The adjudication of these awards will be carried out by a judge appointed by the Committee and his decision will be considered as final. All exhibits considered worthy will receive an award.

JUDGING COMMENCES AT 8.00AM ON SUNDAY 27th JUNE 2010

The marquee is open to the public after judging at approximately 9.30am when stands should be fully staffed. The sale of Plants, Flowers and Seeds only, will be permitted in the Trade/Flower Tent subject to the following rules:

Exhibitors wishing to sell will be provided with a 6' x 2' table adjacent to their exhibition stand and selling may only be conducted from this table. Any exhibitor wishing to sell in the Trade/Flower Tent must notify the Secretary when sending in their entry form. The Secretary's decision as to the siting of each exhibitors selling table in relation to his stand is final.

There will be no cost for a selling table in 2010 due, once again, to the generosity of the late Mr. William Gamble. As in 2009 the prize money has been increased to reflect the increased costs faced by exhibitors. Mr. Gamble passed away in December but made sure that I receive his sponsorship after the 2009 show and in his words "Just in case I'm not here!" We are in his debt.

Nothing may be sold or moved from the Exhibition stand before 4.30pm on Show Day. Selling must be tidy and well organized, the table must be stocked from behind the exhibition stand as much as possible and the sale material must be brought into the tent before 8.00am on the morning of the Show. Exhibitors are allowed to sell seeds, cut flowers and plants and, in addition, a small proportion of their selling table may be given over to accessories or sundries associated with their particular specialty.

Exhibitors are welcome to stage from 9.00am on the Friday prior to the show. Staging will be provided by the Society to the design overleaf. We will provide some lighting for late exhibitors.

There will be ample Car Parking for exhibitors behind and to the rear of the marquee.

The marquee this year will be sited, as in 2009, near the main entrance to the showground on the main thoroughfare.

Staging depth and frontage must be selected and state whether an edge board is required and if so of what dimensions. Backing rails will be a standard 7ft high. Each exhibitor will receive two exhibitors admissions tickets and one vehicle pass. A selling table is available if required

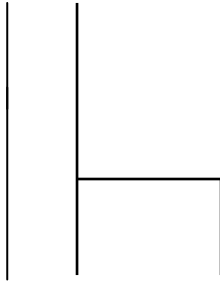
