- Class 1** June Fanfare – An exhibit. Space allowed 90cms wide x 60cms deep. Height optional. The Joy Davenport Memorial Cup will be presented to the winner of this class.
- Class 2** Carousel - An exhibit. Space allowed 90cms wide x 60cms deep. Height optional. The Brenda Scammell Bronze tazza will be awarded to the winner of this class.
- Class 3** The Green Gifts of Nature - an exhibit. Space allowed 90cms wide x 60cms deep. Height optional.
- Class 4** Salvaged Treasure – an exhibit to include driftwood. Space allowed 90cms wide x 60cms deep. Height optional. The Lewis Cup will be awarded to the winner of this class.
- Class 5** The Apothecary's Shop – An exhibit. Space allowed 90cms wide x 60cms deep. Height optional. The William Gamble crystal bowl will be awarded to the winner of this class.
- Class 6** Land Before Time – An exhibit. Space allowed 90cms wide x 60cms deep. Height optional.
- Class 7** The Tea Party - A petite exhibit. Not to exceed 25cms in width, depth and height. This exhibit may be completed at home prior to staging.

CRAFT CLASS

- Class 8** The Celebration. A napkin ring – Please display with a napkin. Fresh or dried/preserved plant material may be used to decorate the napkin ring. Bench space allowed 30cms wide x 30cms deep to display exhibit. This exhibit may be completed at home prior to staging.

- Class 9** 8 – 11 years – Birthday Cake in flowers. Space allowed 60cms x 60cms Height optional. This exhibit may be completed at home prior to staging.
- Class 10** 12 to 16 years - The Queen's Diamond Jubilee – Party Table Arrangement. Space allowed 90cms x 60cms. Height optional. This exhibit may be completed at home prior to staging.

RULES AND INFORMATION FOR THE FLORAL ART SECTION

Judging will be undertaken by a fully accredited NAFAS Judge in accordance with the Competitor's Manual 2nd Edition 2009 which is available from the National Secretary, NAFAS, Osborne house, 12 Devonshire Square, London EC2M 4TE. A copy will be available in the Floral Art Section on staging day.

Exhibits may be staged on the Saturday of Show weekend from 9.00am to 9.00pm. (Please note earlier start) and also on Show Day (Sunday) from 6.00am to 7.00am.

All exhibits to be competitor's own work, arranged in the marquee without assistance with the exception of Classes 7, 8, 9 10 and 11 which may be prepared at home but must be the unaided work of the exhibitor.

The judge's decision is final.

Exhibitors are requested wherever possible not to use as accessories any article of value as the Derbyshire Agricultural & Horticultural Society or its officers accept no responsibility for loss or damage however caused.

Prize money will be sent to exhibitors by cheque in the week following the show.

Exhibits not to be dismantled before 4.30pm on Show Day. Exhibitors cards, passes etc needed for Show Day will be given to you on staging day.

Draping will be blue in colour as in 2011. A sample can be made available for new arrangers.

Closing date for entries will be 1st June 2012. Late entries accepted in exceptional circumstances.
